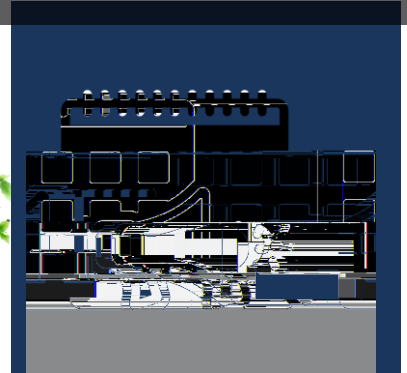
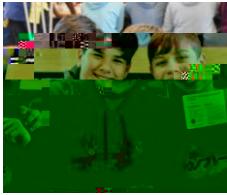
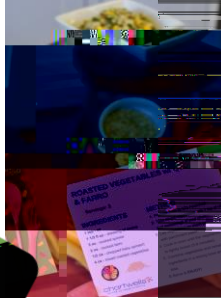
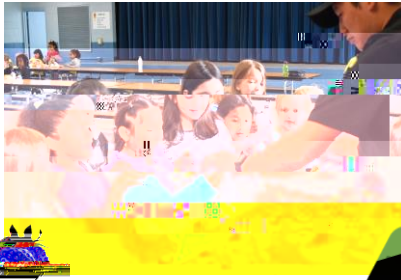


RECAP + COMING UP
