## General:

Use pencil for written work unless otherwise noted.

Use crayons or color pencils inside your journal. Markers should be reserved for cardstock items or items without print on the back, as they tend to bleed through.

Use the front and back of each page in your journal.

Date all pages/work. No need to put a name on each page in the bound books (journals, handwriting book, math, etc.). Just place the date in the designated name space.

Take pictures of work on a flat surface so it is easily seen. \*if uploading to turn in during quarantine\* I ndependent work means no help or prompting from an adult. It is for the child to show what he or she knows and is separate from teaching and coaching.

Use the ESGI assessment reports to work with your student on skills he or she demonstrates as not mastered.
