HOMEWORK POLICY

TRANSPORTATION CHANGES

All transportation changes must be in writing. Car riders must have a school issued paper on the dashboard or window of the car picking them up with his/her name on it. Students are NOT dismissed through car line unless the car tag is located in the car. If you do not have the car tag, you will be asked to go to the office to sign your child out. Please remember that this policy is for the safety of your child.

REWARDS AND CONSEQUENCES

7. Office Referral and Parent Conference
