- B. CONSENT ITEMS: The following items will be voted on as a group. Individual items may be discussed prior to a vote being taken.
  - 1. Ratification of Expulsions (Dr. Alford)

The School Board, according to the Code of Laws of South Carolina Sections 59-63-240, is authorizes to expel students from school. Although the Board may receive recommendations for expulsion from others, it solely is empowered to take the final expulsion action.

2. Out-of-District Transfer Requests (Mr. Laurence)

Board Policy JFABC allows the Aiken County Board of Education to arrange with other school districts for the interchange of students. The policy stipulates that when students transfer out of the District, "the School District of Aiken County shall assume no responsibility for tuition to the receiving district."

3. Potash Donation to Belvedere Elementary School – FY17 (Dr. Washington)

Belvedere Elementary was given a \$1,500 donation from Potash for their Science Day. The funds from this donation will be used to pay for the two speakers and activities for the Science Day.

4. Purchase of C-Cans for Aiken County Public Schools Operations Center (Dr. Foster)

Bids were received on March 23, 2017 at 2:00 p.m. from 1 bidder and publicly opened. Touax Modular was the low bidder at \$29,700.00. Base Bid A is to purchase (9) 9'-6" storage containers for the maintenance department.

5. Adult Education and Family Literacy/Engagement Collaborative Grant – FY18 (Dr. Washington)

Freedman Parenting Center was awarded \$17,980 from the Adult Education and Family Literacy/Engagement Collaborative Grant. The funds from this grant will provide adult education students who are parents or guardians of children ages birth to eight with an opportunity to improve their academic skills and to use those skills to enhance the literacy skills of their children.
