

## School Improvement Council Meeting- Minutes

1. Financial Update from PTO-
  - a. PTO has a balance of approximately 19,200.00.
  - b. Recent Fundraisers and money raised:
    - i. Pickles and Popcorn-\$100.00
    - ii. Three 1<sup>st</sup> Fridays- \$184.00
    - iii. Concessions from Literacy Night- \$360.00
    - iv. Silent Auction from Literacy Night- \$400
    - v. Holiday Court King/Queen- \$8016.00(not all of that is profit)
    - vi. Bundt Cake Fundraiser- \$3200.00
  - c. PTO spent some money for Teacher Appreciation gifts for Christmas

in teaching. We hope to invite fifteen students per teacher, and end up with ten to twelve students per teacher.

- vii. Other Updates from Mrs. Padgett- We currently have one certified tutor working in the building. We are working on another applicant as well.

4. Data Update-

- a. MAP Data from Fall to Winter-
    - i. Math from 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> Grade shows a 5% gain in students scoring in the Meets/Exceeds categories
    - ii. There was a 2.8% gain in Math and we are on target to meet the End of Year Goal
    - iii. Reading growth was not as remarkable. Teachers are using guided reading in their classes and making sure lessons are aligned to standards that are tested and this is making a difference.
5. Goals for School Improvement Council for 2022-2023 School year:
- a. Engage parents by holding elections for offices, implement Family Nights and conduct involvement activities
    - i. We had our Fall Literacy Night, and the Spring Literacy Night is planned
    - ii. We will be offering workshops to parents in the Spring.

6. School Reading Plan-

- a. The plan was focused on our 3<sup>rd</sup> Graders. The goal was to decrease the percentage of
