- I. At all times, participants in the North Augusta Robotics Team (NART) will follow the Student Code of Conduct set forth by Aiken County Public Schools. A copy of the most current Code of Conduct will be maintained in the Robotics room at North Augusta High School (NAHS).
- II. Participation in NART is a privledge, not a right. If selected to represent NAHS and NART, participants agree to comply with the Aiken County Public Schools Code of Conduct/high schools and this Code of Ethics.
- III. Students, Mentors, and Parents will only be allowed access to the Robotics room and the closest restroom facility during all build sessions and meetings. Use of any other room or facility on school property will require prior approval through the proper channels. There will be no other warning related to school/room access. Participants who violate this provision will be removed from the team and reported to the proper school authorities.
- IV. Specifically, participants shall not loiter on school grounds nor explore the school grounds during build sessions. This is explicitly prohibited by the Student Code of Conduct.
- V. The teacher liaison, program manager, mentors, and parents will be obeyed with regards to behavior or activities.
- VI. Participants will show respect to others at all times. This includes respect to the teacher(s), program manager, mentors, parents, and other students.
- VII. Profanity, disrespectful or lewd behavior, or other disruptive behavior will not be tolerated during build sessions, meetings, competitions, or other designated field trips.
- VIII. Participants agree to provide meaningful participation to the assigned team and the NART. Lack of participation will result in removal from the team and NART.
- IX. Participants agree to regularly attend build sessions throughout the season. Lack of attendance will result in removal from the team and NART. Parents will be notified of lack of attendance and removal from the team.
